

CLASS DEFINITIONS/RULES:

**** Please note new division, or division changes.**

Lead Line: Open to riders 8 years and under. Hunter to be judged on manners and suitability at the walk, Equitation judged on position and suitability. Ground Pole to be judged on riders position and equitation, both directions of the ring. Walk over ground pole. Rider may be asked for Two-Point Position while on the rail and may be asked simple questions about their horse or tack. Rider may not enter any other classes the day of the show, except classes 104-106..

Walk off the lead: Open to riders 8 years and under. Hunter to be judged on manners and suitability at the walk. Equitation judged on position and suitability. Ground Pole to be judged on riders position and equitation, both directions of the ring. Walk over ground pole in half seat (2 point) . Rider may be asked for Two-Point Position while on the rail and also may be asked simple questions about the horse or tack. Handler may stand in the center of the ring for assistance. Rider may not enter any other classes the day of the show, except classes 101-103

Walk/Trot off the lead: Open to riders 10 years and under. Hunter to be judged on manners and suitability at the walk and trot, Equitation judged on position and suitability. Ground Pole to be judged on riders position and equitation, both directions of the ring. Walk over ground pole in half seat (2 point). Rider may be asked for Two-Point Position while on the rail and also may be asked simple questions about the horse or tack. Handler may stand in the center of the ring for assistance. If asked by judge, handler may assist rider at the trot. Rider may not enter any other classes the day of the show.

Walk/Trot 10-under: Open to riders 10 and under. Hunter to be judged on performance and soundness, Equitation judged on rider. To be shown walk and trot both directions of the ring, and jump one cross rail (12"). Horse and rider combination not eligible for any other classes the day of show except 119-121

Walk/Trot 11-17: Open to riders 11-17. Hunter to be judged on performance and soundness, Equitation judged on rider. To be shown walk and trot both directions of the ring, and jump one cross rail (12"). Horse and rider combination not eligible for any other classes the day of show except 119-121

****INDIVIDUAL** Canter: Open to all riders, to be shown walk and trot both directions of the ring, then canter one direction for each class INDIVIDUALLY. Hunter to be judged on performance and soundness. Equitation judged on rider. Horse and rider combination not eligible for any other classes the day of show except classes 110-118.

****CANTER DIVISION:** Open to all riders, to be shown at walk, trot, and canter. Jump class to be shown either at trot or canter over 4 jumps (outside 4 jumps) height not to exceed 18". Jumps may be set as verticals or cross rails from 12"-18". Hunter to be judged on performance and soundness. Equitation judged on rider. Riders may not enter any other "DIVISIONS" the day of the show, with the exception of speciality classes or warm-up classes.

****NO STIRRUP NOVEMBER CLASS:** (Speciality class only at Nov. 2020 show) Open to all riders to compete in a single equitation flat class. Riders may be asked to halt, reverse, walk, trot, canter seated, posting and in two point positions. 1st place **Prize & 1-6 ribbons awarded.**

ALL WARM UP CLASSES: Open Card: Open to all riders, to be judged on performance and soundness. To jump min of 8 jumps heights as indicated in schedule. No year end points. Not included in any division points. This is used strictly as a schooling prior to your division height. 1-6 Ribbons will be pinned.

Short Stirrup: Open to riders 12 years or younger. Classes over fences shall consist of max 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height over a simple course. Hunter to be judged on performance and soundness. Equitation judged on rider. Flat classes to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Riders are permitted to trot into their first jump only, remainder of course must be done at canter. Simple changes allowed. Same horse and rider combination shall not enter any other jumping classes the day of show.

Long Stirrup: Open to riders 13 years and older Classes over fences shall consist of max 8 fences not exceeding 18" in height over a simple course. Hunter to be judged on performance and soundness. Equitation judged on rider. Flat classes to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Riders are permitted to trot into their first jump only, remainder of course must be done at canter. Simple changes allowed. Same horse and rider combination shall not enter any other jumping classes the day of show.

Beginner Equitation: Open to all riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing, to be judged on rider only. Over fences shall consist of 6-8 fences (not exceeding 2' in height). Flat class to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Riders are permitted to trot into their first jump only, remainder of course must be done at canter. Simple changes allowed. Same horse/rider combination may not jump higher than 2'3" day of show.

Schooling Hunter: Open to all riders, to be judged on performance and soundness. Classes over fences shall consist 6-8 fences not exceeding 2' in height. Flat class to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Riders are permitted to trot into their first jump only, remainder of course must be done at canter. Simple

changes allowed. Horse and rider combination can't jump higher than 2'3" day of show.

Low Hunter: Open to all riders, to be judged on performance and soundness. Over fences shall consist of 6-10 fences not exceeding 2'3" in height. Flat to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Horse and rider combination shall not jump higher than 2'6" day of show.

Limited Child/Adult Equitation: Open to junior/amateur riders. To be judged on rider. Over fences will consist of 6-10 fences not exceeding 2'3" in height. Flat to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Horse and rider combination can't jump higher than 2'6" day of show.

Child/Adult Hunter: Open to all riders. To be judged on performance and soundness. Over fences shall consist of 6-10 fences not exceeding 2'6" in height. Flat to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Horse and rider combination shall not jump higher than 2'9" day of show.

Child/Adult Equitation: Open to all junior/amateur riders. To be judged on rider. Over fences shall consist of 6-10 fences not exceeding 2'6" in height. Flat to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Horse and rider combination shall not jump higher than 2'9" day of show.

Working Hunter: Open to all riders, to be judged on performance and soundness. Over fences shall consist of 6-10 fences not to exceed 2'9". Flat to be shown at walk, trot, and canter both directions.

Amateur Equitation: Open to all junior/amateur riders. To be judged on rider. Over fences shall consist of 6-10 fences not exceeding 2'9' in height. Flat to be shown at walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring .

We reserve the right to cancel, split or combine classes/divisions based on the amount of entries per class/division.

Short Stirrup & Long Stirrup will be a combined division if either division has less than 2 riders.

THERE WILL BE A STRICT 2 MINUTE GATE CALL FOR ALL CLASSES UNLESS PERMISSION IS ARRANGED AHEAD OF TIME WITH A SHOW OFFICIAL.
